1. Teaching experience in a doctoral level counseling psychology program.
2. Active membership in the American Psychological Association.
3. Dissertation or research supervision at the doctoral level.
4. Suitable range of publications in peer-reviewed journals and presentations in counseling psychology.
5. Interest in multicultural issues and diversity; and/or ethics.

**Responsibilities:**

1. Provide instruction in the counseling psychology program as well as the counseling/rehabilitation counseling programs, as qualified.
2. Chair dissertations and serve on dissertation committees.
3. Provide academic advising to doctoral and possibly master's students, if needed.
4. Facilitate graduate student research, publication, and professional activities.
5. Undertake a significant research and publication agenda.
6. Undertake service responsibilities to the Department, College, University, and professional field.
