4. Research and scholarly activities commensurate with assistant or associate professor rank.

Preferred Qualifications:

1. Teaching experience in a doctoral level counseling psychology program as well as a master's level counseling program.
2. Active membership in the American Psychological Association and/or American Counseling Association.
3. Dissertation or research supervision at the doctoral level.
4. Suitable range of publications in peer-reviewed journals and presentations in counseling and/or counseling psychology.
5. For the Counseling Psychology program, interest, experience, and background in multicultural issues and diversity.
6. For the Counselor Educator program, interest and experience in testing, ethics, career counseling, practicum/internship, and possibly adolescents/children.

Responsibilities:

1. Provide instruction in the counseling psychology program as well as the counseling/rehabilitation counseling programs, as qualified.
2. Chair dissertations and serve on dissertation committees.
3. Provide academic advising to doctoral and master's students.
4. Facilitate graduate student research, publication, and professional activities.
5. Undertake a significant research and publication agenda.
6. Undertake service responsibilities to the Department, College, University, and professional field.
