Position: Assistant/Associate Professor in Higher Education Leadership Program, Tenure Track
Nine-month appointment

Required Qualifications:

1. Earned doctorate in higher education leadership or closely related field. Consideration may be extended to candidates who are enrolled in a doctoral program with the understanding that completion of the doctorate by the time of appointment, August 16, 2008, will be a condition of hiring.
2. Record of research and publication in refereed journals or substantial evidence of potential for success as a scholar in important areas of higher education
3. Experience as an administrator

Preferred Qualifications:

1. Graduate teaching experience in academic administration, governance in higher education, assessment, and higher education administration.
2. Demonstrated record of presentations at local, regional, and national higher education conferences.
3. Participation in grant and contract development.
4. Experience and fluency in teaching via distance education or other innovative technologies.

Responsibilities:

1. Teach graduate courses in higher education leadership/administration.
2. Deliver courses face-to-face and also through synchronous and asynchronous online instruction.
3. Advise graduate students and supervise practica/internships.
4. Supervise doctoral student progress in the program and dissertation research.
5. Implement a productive research agenda to higher education leadership/administration.
6. Write proposals and secure external funding to support teaching, research, and service efforts.
7. Establish and maintain positive interdisciplinary relationships with the faculty within the College and across the University.
8. Provide service to the College, the University, the State, the public schools, and the discipline.
