**The Department of Speech Pathology & Audiology:**

The Department offers an undergraduate preprofessional degree in speech-language pathology and audiology, an M. S. degree in speech-language pathology, and the Doctorate of Audiology (Au.D.). The graduate programs in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology hold CAA accreditation. There are approximately 120 undergraduate and 60 graduate students. Academic and clinical facilities have undergone recent renovation.

**Qualifications:**

1. Earned doctorate in Speech-Language Pathology.
2. Eligible for licensure in the state of West Virginia.
3. Hold the Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC-SLP)

**Preferred Qualifications:**

1. Expertise in voice, cognitive-communication, or child language/literacy disorders is *preferred*, but *all areas of expertise will be considered*.
2. ABD candidates will be considered but preference will be given to applicants with the doctorate.

**Responsibilities:**

1. Teaching graduate and undergraduate classes.
2. Clinical supervision.
3. Service consisting of student advising and committee work.
4. Research involving the presentation of original research at professional meetings and publishing in peer-reviewed journals.

**Salary:** Salary is based on qualifications and experience; summer employment is possible.

**Morgantown and the University:**
